

GANG TATTOO REMOVAL PROGRAM



THE DEPARTMENT OF DERMATOLOGY IS STARTING A FREE GANG-RELATED TATTOO REMOVAL PROGRAM.

- Program open to participants in a confirmed re-entry program with a written recommendation from the program coordinator.
- Tattoos must be in visible locations (hands, face, neck) and be gang related.
- Participants must be available for an initial consult to determine if tattoo can be treated effectively.
- Participants should expect to undergo at least six to eight treatments in two or three month intervals. Failure to attend two sessions may lead to removal from the program.
- Some tattoos may not fully clear.
- Patients may develop light or dark spots after treatment.
